

Chickamauga Battlefield CANNON HIKE

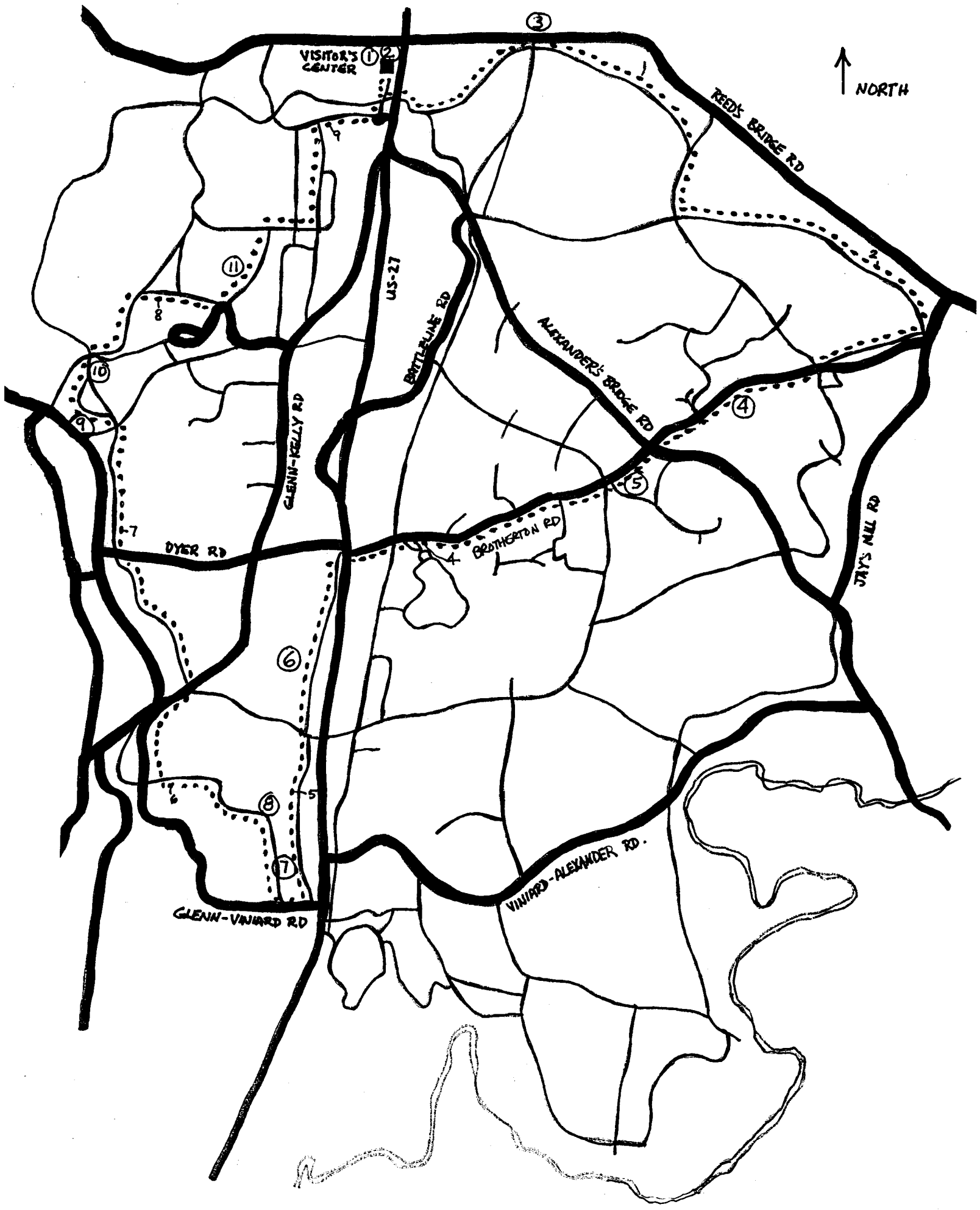
Distance: 9 Miles

The Cannon Hike begins at the Visitor's Center. Place the answers to the following questions in the space provided.

1. Outside the main entrance to the Visitor Center is a row of cannons. Which cannon had the greatest range?
2. What type of cannon is on the front porch of the Visitor Center facing US-27?
3. Now proceed south along US-27 to culvert and cross under the highway. Follow the trail around behind the Florida Monument and take the first trail on the left. Follow this trail in an eastward direction to the first dirt road. Turn left (north) and proceed to Reeds Bridge Road. What State's batteries are represented by this monument?
4. Return south to the trail and turn left at the first trail intersection. Turn right on the trail where it intersects a north-south path, then turn left at the 4-way intersection and head to the site of Jay's Mill. Turn right on the trail and then proceed west along Brotherton Road to the third battery on the left. What was the rank of the Alabama Battery Commander?
5. Continue west crossing Alexander's Bridge Road. Stop at the first cannon on the left. What was the Commanding Officer's name & rank?
6. Proceed on west and carefully cross over US-27. Turn left (south) along line of monuments south of the cabin and proceed to the cannon at the south end of the field. What type of cannon is this?
7. Continue south into the woodline where you will find a small foot trail. Follow the trail to a dirt road and bear left until you cross a culvert. Turn right immediately beyond the culvert and follow the trail southward past Heg's Monument. Continue southward until you reach a paved road. Turn right to the first plaque on the right (Dick's Brigade). Step into the field and follow the woodline northwest to the first battery. What northern State is represented by this battery?
8. Continue northward along the woodline to the next battery position. Who commanded this battery?
9. Follow edge of field west until you come to the Glenn-Kelly Road. Turn right along the road and then turn left at the sign for General Lytle's Monument. Pass Lytle's Monument and continue northward, crossing Dyer Road and the dirt Vittetoe Road. Dent's Battery is to the left of the main trail. What State is represented by this battery?
10. Proceed north to the Cross Monument. Who erected this monument?
11. Turn right at the next trail intersection where you face the 121st Ohio Monument, and then turn right at the next trail which takes you past Thomas' HQ monument and up to the Snodgrass Cabin. What state provided most of the batteries located in the line of monuments near the cabin ?
Follow the line of monuments until you reach a path along the woodline. Turn right, and then left where the trail intersects a paved road. Turn right where the road ends to exit the woods and return to the Visitor's Center.
